The Clerk reported that Bolsover District Council had repaired the potholes in the Cemetery path. A District Council representative had also offered to obtain a quote for a water connection to the Cemetery, to allow the installation of a tap, and also a quote for relaying part of the Cemetery footpath. It was also reported that a reply had not yet been received from Derbyshire County Council in response to County Councillor Stockdale's request about cutting back the trees between the Cemetery and Outgang Lane.

<u>RESOLVED</u> that the report be noted and that further consideration is given to the water connection and relaying of the path on receipt of the quotes.

The Clerk reported that two additional dog poo bag dispensers had been installed. One near the footbridge at the top of Terrace Lane, Pleasley and the other at the entrance to the Rotherham Road Recreation Ground near to the Social Club. It was also reported that overgrown trees and vegetation on Prideway 14, which ising Newboundmill Lang at the back of the

Bridleway 14, which joins Newboundmill Lane at the back of the Terrace Lance Recreation Ground, will be cut back by Derbyshire County Council over the winter.

The Clerk reported that the reply received by County Councillor Stockdale, from Derbyshire County Council, in response to the request about cutting the trees near the footbridge over the A617, was that in their opinion no work was required. This response has been challenged on the basis that their survey may not have identified the correct trees. The Clerk has issued a further request for a reevaluation of this decision.

The Clerk also reported that the work to erect the bus shelter on Chesterfield Road, at the Bus Stand, near Meden Vale Engineering, is still on-going.

(ii) A discussion was held to consider the replacement of the two bus shelters, adjacent to and opposite to Anthony Bek Primary School, on the A617 Chesterfield Road

<u>RESOLVED</u> that an application is made to Derbyshire County Council to implement the process to replace both bus shelters on behalf of Pleasley Parish Council. The council will enter into an agreement to contribute fifty percent of the cost and then adopt the bus shelter, taking full responsibility for on-going cleaning, maintenance and repair costs.

New Houghton Community Centre

(i) The Clerk reported that the NHCC Intruder Alarm system could receive a free upgrade to a system which provides

monitoring through the GPRS system, rather than the existing landline. Although the annual monitoring fee will increase, this will be more than offset by the savings made in comparison to the costs of the current system which incurs call charges when the alarm is set, unset or activated. This will also allow the removal of the payphone, to which the system is currently connected, providing additional savings on landline rental charges.

<u>RESOLVED</u> that the offer of the free upgrade is accepted.

(ii) The Clerk presented three quotes for the supply and fit of blinds to the Main Hall in the Community Centre.

<u>RESOLVED</u> that approval is given to accept the best value quote to supply and fit blinds to the Main Hall in the Community Centre.
